
Dear Mr Ramshaw

At our recent AGM a motion was passed unanimously to support the reopening of the Waverley Viaduct, for walkers and cyclists.

We are a walking group with 182 members, the vast majority residents of Carlisle. We walk regularly in the local area both on club organised walks and individually. Many of our long standing members will have used the viaduct in the past when it was available as a crossing of the river Eden by the public.

We feel it is long overdue for this historic structure to be used for the benefit of residents and visitors to Carlisle. It will add to the network of footpaths and cycle routes, will link the Hadrian's Wall path with the Cumbria Way and provide a traffic free crossing point for residents of the west of the city which is relatively close to the centre of the city.
